## **Victoria Bolen Performing Arts Scholarship**

Victoria Bolen was a shining star in her performing/teaching career. Her sister Patsy is trying to maintain that light for QHS students even after Victoria's 2003 death in the establishment of a performing arts scholarship.

Victoria (QHS class of 1964) graduated from the University of Utah Cum Laude in 1969 with a Bachelor of Fine Arts degree in dance, then two years later graduated Magna Cum Laude with a Masters of Fine Arts degree in choreography from the same school.

Trained in various forms of dance; ballet, modern, jazz, and character tap; Victoria performed across the United States and Europe. She also did choreography for dance and theatre companies across the country; consulted in dance in various educational settings, including large public school districts, universities, regional arts festivals; and held membership in several arts council. She was named "Outstanding Teacher of the Year" by the Tennessee Governor's School for the Arts.

With a \$1000 performing arts scholarship, in its hope that more of this spirit will be spread to future performers of the arts and those who aid in performance (I.E. theatre tech) from Quinter. Quinter had an impact on Victoria, where she picked up her deep personal values and optimistic view of life. There she began her music and dance training, and developed a love of people.
