Due to the cost to the district, Mr. Brown will not apply for the KDHE new clean diesel bus grant.

HS parking lot bids from QMC, Bettis Asphalt & Construction, Inc., and Sweeney's Pavement Maintenance, LLC were reviewed by the board.

**Superintendent's Report:**

Mr. Brown reviewed legislative bills. The board reviewed enrollment of nonresident students capacity. The Technology committee discussed Chromebook use at the elementary level. Technology committee recommended to no longer continue 1 to 1 chromebook use for K-3 grade students, limit Chromebook use in grades 4-6 to classroom instruction, and for state assessments only. Mr. Brown discussed summer At-Risk services.

Motion to approve elementary Chromebook use policy as presented. Anstett/Herl (m/s/c 6-0)

**New Business:**

Donation from Don & Charla Tilton and Don Tilton CPA \$1,000 for band meals at state events, and American Heart Association \$100 for PE Supplies. A company offering a HVAC maintenance contract visited with Mr. Brown but has not sent a quote yet. Health insurance renewal rates were reviewed.

Mr. Brown is still waiting on a bid to replace a portion of the GS hallway flooring this summer.

**Personnel Report:**

Kahne Johnson resigned as asst. HS boys basketball coach; Sandee Mountain-Scott and Ashley Roehl resigned from teaching positions; Don Tilton resigned as head JH girls basketball coach. Mr. Brown recommended Kaylie Bockwinkel and Emma Borell as GS Teachers. Mr. Countryman recommended Keagan Shubert as asst. HS boys basketball, and contract modification for Kassie Remington to an eleven month contract.
