Official Minutes of Special Board Meeting
November 30, 2020

Call to Order:

Agenda Items:

The meeting was held to discuss the items for which the meeting was called: Winter Music Concerts (A), District Broadcasting of School Activities (A), Personnel - (Executive Session and/or Action), Student Issues - (Executive Session and/or Action) and Negotiations - (Executive Session and/or Action). Notification of the special meeting was emailed out on Wednesday, October 28, 2020.

Winter Music Concerts:

The board, Administration, and staff attending discussed extending the KSHAA rule of no audience to the winter concerts. Concerts could be live broadcasted with the assistance of FHSU. A drive in movie theater in the parking lot could be set up so that parents can bring their child and then sit in their car and watch the concert. School offered transportation for any child where the parent is unable or unwilling to drive them in would be provided if it works with the transportation department. Concert dates are as follows: The K-3 concert will be Monday, December 7th at 7:00pm and the 4-6 concert will be Tuesday, December 15th at 6:30pm and the 7-12 concert will be Tuesday, December 15th at 8:00pm.

Action Item:

Motion to not allow spectators to the winter concerts and have Mr. Brown check into transporting students to and from the concerts. Werth/Betz (m/s/c 5-1)

District Broadcasting of School Activities:

Mr. Brown would like to purchase professional video equipment to be able to broadcast JH & HS home and away games. A mixer will also need to be purchased to connect cameras videoing at the same time. Cost of equipment could be as high as \$16,000.

Aaron Betz adjourned the Board of Education meeting at 8:08pm.


