Grade School Building Report:

Mrs. Zeigler is expanding thinking in Kindergarten to include Mind Development using visualization. There will be large student numbers in 5th and 6th grades so additional personnel may be needed if more students enroll.

The calendar committee is requesting to move the day off in February to line up with Presidents Day. This would move the day from Monday, February 12th to Monday, February 19th. NWKL JH music festival was held last month and Quinter kids did outstanding. Quinter had two advance performance, nineteen I ratings, and two II ratings. Spring break will happen just in time because illness is hitting the students at the junior and senior high. State Assessments will begin after spring break along with spring activities.

Mrs. Zeigler has signed a food consortium agreement again for next school year. State wide Health plan for education has proven to not be workable. Gove county clerk has submitted the election plan to the state for approval to have a mail ballot for board election with an estimated election date of June 6th.
